Section 139AA of the Income-tax Act - Quoting of Aadhaar Number

#### CBDT press release, dated 14/2/2019

As per section 139AA of the Income-tax Act and the order dated 30/6/2018 of CBDT, Aadhaar-PAN linking is mandatory now which has to be completed till 31/3/2019 by the PAN holder requiring filing of Income-tax Return. The Constitutional validity of Aadhaar has been upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in September 2018. The procedure for Aadhaar-PAN linking has been published vide Notification No. 7 dated 29/6/2017 by Principal Director General of Income Tax (Systems).

#### Order F. No. 225/15/2019/ITA.II, dated 27/2/2019

The CBDT vide Order F. No. 225/15/2019/ITA.II, dated 27/2/2019 and in exercise of powers u/s. 119(2) of the Act, hereby directs that in case of taxpayers of Kerala for whom the due date for filing return of Income & Report of Audit pertaining to assessment year 2018-19 was 31/10/2018, all returns of income and reports of audit which are filed till 28/2/2019 shall be deemed to have been filed by 31/10/2018.

#### **Supreme Court**

#### 37(1) Expenditure vis-à-vis share of profit

Assessee society have paid sugarcane purchase price to members/non-members in excess/above price determined under Clauses 3 & 5A of Control Order, 1966. However, entire/ whole amount of difference between Statutory Minimum Price (SMP) and State Advice Price (SAP) per se cannot be said to be an appropriation of profit. It was observed that merely because the higher price is paid to members and non-members, qua the members, still the question would remain with respect to the distribution of profit/sharing of the profit.

Buro Happold Limited vs. Dy. Commissioner of Income Tax (IT), Circle - 1(3)(2), Mumbai [TS-76-ITAT-2019(Mum)] dated 15th February 2019

#### **Facts**

- The assessee, a tax resident of UK was engaged in the business of providing engineering design and consultancy services.
- The assessee had earned an amount of ₹ 1,09,03,039/towards the provision of consulting engineering services and ₹ 1,01,44,808/- as a common cost recharge towards head office expenses from Buro Happold Engineers India Pvt. Ltd. (BHEI).
- AO was of the opinion that the provision of consulting engineering services and common cost recharge are in the nature of 'Fees for Technical Services' (FTS) as per Article

13(4)(c) of India-UK DTAA agreement and therefore, levied tax at 15% on the gross amount.

Aggrieved, the assessee filed an appeal at Mumbai ITAT.

In terms of extant regulations, applications received from a Non-Government Organisation, Non-Profit Organisation, Body/ Agency/Department of a foreign Government for opening of a BO or a LO or a PO or any other place of business in India are forwarded to the RBI for prior approval to be considered in consultation with the Government of India.

This has been reviewed and as notified through Notification No. FEMA Notification No. 22(R)(1) dated August 31, 2018, it is advised that if such an entity is engaged, partly or wholly, in any of the activities covered under Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010 (FCRA), it shall obtain a certificate of registration under the said Act and shall not seek permission under FEMA Notification No. 22(R). Accordingly, the Form FNC has also been suitably modified.

#### CBC report exchange between India and USA

The absence of an agreement between India and USA till now entailed a possibility of local filing of CbC Reports in India. However, a Bilateral Competent Authority Arrangement, along with an underlying Inter-Governmental Agreement, for exchange of CbC Reports between India and the USA has now been finalised. This would enable both the countries to exchange CbC Reports filed by the ultimate parent entities of International Groups in the respective jurisdictions, pertaining to the financial years commencing on or after 1st January, 2016. As a result, Indian constituent entities of international groups headquartered in USA, who have already filed CbC Reports in the USA, would not be required to do local filing of the CbC Reports of their international groups in India.

CBIC vide Notification No. 8/2019-CT dated 8th February, 2019 has extended the time limit for furnishing the FORM GSTR-7 (return by registered person who is required to deduct TDS) for the month of January, 2019 till 28th February, 2019.

CBIC vide Notification No. 9/2019-CT dated 20th February, 2019 has extended the time limit for furnishing the FORM GSTR-3B for the month of January, 2019 till 28th February, 2019 for person having principal place in State of Jammu Kashmir & till 22nd February, 2019 for rest of the states.

#### **GST-ADVANCE RULINGS** CA. C. B. Thakar, CA. Jinal Maru



Case: Sarj Educational Centre - 2019-TIOL-57-AAR-GST (Kolkata)

Facts & Questions: Applicant is the owner of a private boarding house and is providing services of lodging, food, laundry & housekeeping services exclusively to the students of a secondary school run by a Charitable Society. They sought a ruling as to whether the service provided is a composite supply and whether such supply is eligible for exemption under Sl. No. 14 of 12/2017-CTR.

Held: Supply is a mixed supply within the meaning of section 2(74) of the GST Act and is taxable in accordance with section 8(b) of the Act. The value of the entire combination of services offered is taxable at the highest applicable rate @18%.

- Vide Public Circular No. GUJKA/Vat-17-C/18-19/ otw.215/186, dated 1st March, 2019, time limit for filing Annual Return in Form 205 for period 1st April, 2017 to 30th June, 2017, is extended up to 15/3/2019.
- Vide Public Circular No. GUJKA//Vat-17-C/18-19/ otw.215/186, dated 1st March, 2019 time limit for submission of VAT Audit Report in Form 217 for period 1st April, 2017 to 30th June, 2017, is extended up to 31st March, 2019.

#### Ordinance for a Separate Chapter for Housing Societies

New Ordinance published on 9th March 2019 to include a new Housing Chapter in Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act, 1960. The CHS up to 250 members will be able to do the elections internally and the relatives of members may be admitted as Associate members who will be able to contest the election with the consent of original member, penalty of ₹ 100/- per day maximum up to ₹ 5000/- will be levied on the office bearers who fail to provide information as provided in the Act, etc.

#### Association of Allottees to decide the fate of the Registered **Real Estate Project**

Promoter can get extension of project maximum up to one year from the date of revised timeline provided by them while registering the project with MahaRERA. However, upon failure on the part of promoter to complete the project as stipulated above, RERA Authority can revoke the project and hand over the project to other developer but while doing so first chance of refusal is with Association of Allottees.

MahaRERA Order No: 07/2019 dated 8th February 2019 provides that if any developer fails to complete the project within the extended period of one year as provided under section 6 of RERA, such developer may be given further extension based on merits of the each case only after the same is agreed by Association of Allottees by passing Resolution to this effect.

There is an attempt to protect the rights of allottees by giving them option as mentioned above. Promoters will have to be very careful and should always have to co-ordinate with allottees and Association of Allottees.








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
