

- Inspection required indicator by supplier and by item
- Pre-inspection receipts registered as "inventory on hold"
- **❖** On-line inquiry of inspection
- ❖ 'In-process' rejection
- Inspection disposition with audit trail
- ❖ Rejected inventory control
- ❖ Warranty / free replacements tracking
- ❖ Reject reason codes
- **❖** Rejection history records
