









Assistance both for capital and operating expenses to Anchor Institute shall be maximum up to Rs. 10 Cr. subject to Furnishing of 10% of the sanctioned budget (by SLEC) as performance Bank Guarantee.

Scheme 2 : Short-term Bridge Courses by Industries / Institute

Quantum of Assistance


