Scheme 1 : Assistance to MSME Manufacturing sector participation in the Exhibition (National and International)

State Level Exhibition :

- (a) Assistance @75% maximum up to INR 50,000/- (Cost of Stall rent + Cost for product Literature and Display material cost).**
- (b) Expenditure incurred for product Literature and Display material will be limited to INR 10,000/-**

National Level Exhibition :

- (a) Assistance @75% maximum up to INR 1 lakhs (Cost of Stall rent + Cost for product Literature and Display material cost) whichever is less.**

Assistance both for capital and operating expenses to Anchor Institute shall be maximum up to Rs. 10 Cr. subject to Furnishing of 10% of the sanctioned budget (by SLEC) as performance Bank Guarantee.

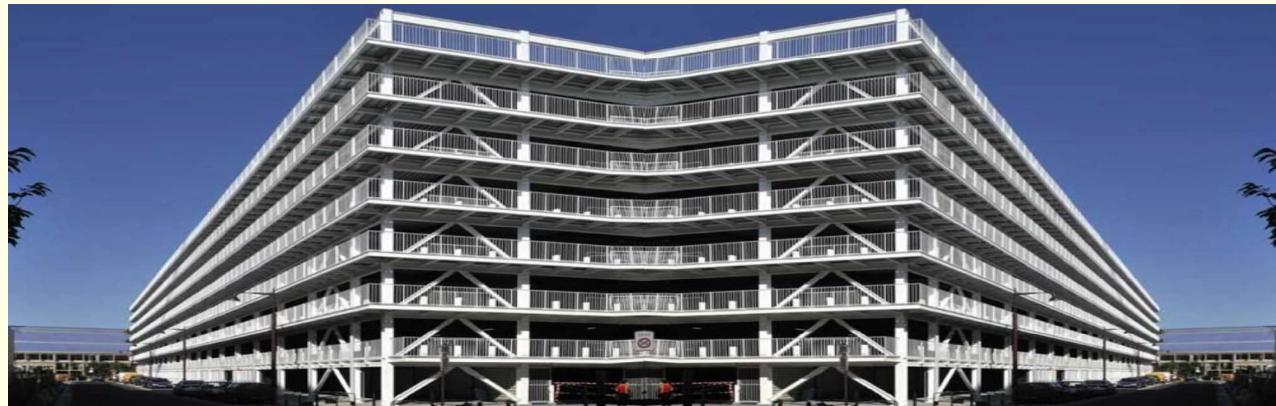
