Recent History of CSR in India

- ► Companies Bill, 2009
- Corporate Voluntary Guidelines 2009 released
- Companies Bill, 2011
- Endorsement of United Nations Guiding Principles on Business & Human Rights by India in 2011
- National Voluntary Guidelines on Social, Environmental and Economic Responsibilities of Business (NVGs) 2011 released
- Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) mandates top 100 listed companies by market capitalization to file Business Responsibility Reports (BRR) based on NVGs in 2012
- Enactment of the Act in 2013
- Section 135 of the Act comes into force in 2014

Section 135 of the Act + The Rules

- ► A regime in motion
- Six rounds of amendments: 2017 and 2019 for the Act; 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2018 for the Rules
- Section 135 not entirely notified for implementation
- Concepts and constructs
- Applicability
- CSR Committee
- CSR Policy
- Deployment of funds
- Portions of Section 135 that are yet to be notified

FAQs/General Circulars/Clarifications

- ► FAQs notified by MCA specifically in 2016
- General Circulars/clarifications prior to as well as after this
- Thrice in 2014 (including office memos for CPSEs)
- Also in 2018
- Special clarification on carry forward of unspent CSR amount
- Certain clarifications for discussion

Trends

- ► CSR internationally
- ► Two High Level Committees on CSR: 2015 and 2018 (Reports submitted in 2016 and 2019)
- National Guidelines on Responsible Business Conduct 2019 released
- Few Indian examples of CSR
