





WHOM TO APPEAL

- (i) Appeal to the State Govt:
 - Whenever an order or decision is made under any section specified in sub-section (1) of 152 appealable to the State Government against the orders and Sanctions approved by the Registrar or the Additional or Joint Registrar.
- (ii) Appeal to, the Registrar. -
 - -Whenever an order or a decision made under any section specified in sub-section (1) of Section 152 made appealable to the Registrar against the order of the Additional or Joint Registrar.

WHOM TO APPEAL

- (ii) Appeal to, the Registrar. -
 - -Appeal lies to the Registrar u/s 23 against a decision of the Society, refusing admission to membership.
- (iii) Appeal to the Co-operative Appellate
 Court. An appeal against an order or
 decision given under Section 79, 85 and
 88 and any order passed by the Registrar
 for paying compensation to Society, and any
 other order for which an appeal can be
 made to the Co-operative Appellate Court.

WHOM TO APPEAL

- Appeal before Joint Registrar: The authorities below passed an order.
- Stay cannot be denied by the joint-Registrar on the ground of maintainability of the appeal specially when the appeal was filed upon the direction of the High Court in earlier writ petitions, Aitwade Ktiurd. Serva seva Sahakari Society Ltd., v. State of Maharashtra, 1994 (1) Mah. L.R.
